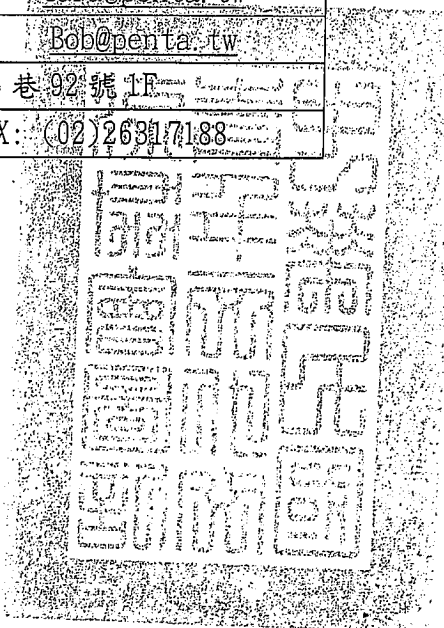

Objective: To find summer camp counselors to work full time at various English camps located throughout Taiwan.

The Youth Cultural Exchange Association, Taiwan (YCEA), founded in 2008, is a unique organization that encourages young people to communicate with the world and to feedback the society with more care and understanding. Through cultural exchange activities and community services, YCEA helps youngsters discover their potential and promotes the embracing of cultural diversity in our society.

The YCEA works closely with Penta. Penta is an International Education Institute that specializes in organizing educational and cultural camps. Penta was founded in 2001 and has since been providing quality summer programs for students in Taiwan and around the world.

Camp Descriptions:

English Leadership Camp

A two week English summer camp for students age 7-16. Counselors will participate in various activities and excursions with the students as well as local Taiwanese counselors. Counselors are expected to speak in English at all times with the students, and to encourage an English speaking environment.

Greenlight Outdoor Nature Camp

A week long English summer camp for students age 7-16. Counselors will participate in various activities and excursions with the students as well as local Taiwanese counselors. Counselors are expected to speak in English at all times with the students, and to encourage an English speaking environment.

Requirements:

- Age 16-23, preferably from USA, Canada, England, Australia, New Zealand, or any other English speaking countries.
- Good communication skills, responsible, patient, flexible. In good physical and mental health,
- Teaching/summer camp experiences not required but strongly recommended.
- Student ID/proof of school enrollment/copy of diploma.

Counselor Responsibilities:

1. Participate in counselor training prior to the beginning of the camp; help set up and clean up after camp.
2. Guiding teenagers and children in activities such as singing campfire songs and staging talent shows, horseback riding, kayaking, swimming, hiking and other outdoor pursuits. (related training will be provided prior to the camp)
3. Enforcing safety rules in the camp and knowing where the campers are at all times; counselors are responsible for the health and safety of their students and provide emotional support, greet new campers and explain all the rules of the camp.
4. Oversee all day-to-day activities. Counselors assist campers with meal times, cleaning up dorms and getting ready for bed. They must ensure that all campers are dressed properly for the weather and the recreational activities they'll participate in on any given day.
5. Interact with them in English, encourage an English friendly environment throughout the camp.

6. Counselors must stay in the same dorm as the students in order to help them with day-to-day needs (especially for younger students)
7. Be able to move around different camp sites.

Incentives:

1. Day trips to local attractions during off days (in between English Leadership Camp at Chang Gung), trip will be paid by Penta.(Option)
2. Local transportation, meals & accommodation, entrance fees to all excursions included.
 - Taipei Tour: Taipei 101, night markets, Langshan temple, Dr. Sun Yat-sen Memorial Hall..
 - Yi-Lan Tour: Yi-Lan old town & traditional festival..
 - Sun Moon Lake Tour
3. Scholarship are awarded at the end of each session: NT\$7000 for 1 session (1 session meaning a 13 day session at the English Leadership Camp)
4. All counselors are insured.
