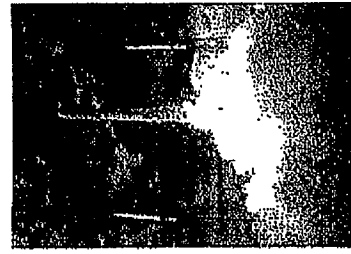

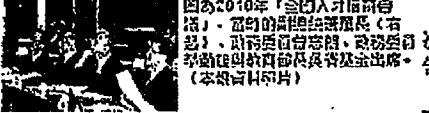

拯救人才危機 先扭轉3代工

2011年8月，馬英九總統聽取台灣的人才問題「驚心動魄」，將人才問題提升到「國安層次」。隔了一年還只是聽到國科會主委朱敬一警告：台灣進入人才斷層，再無作為，與他國競爭「死狀甚慘」，2010年行政院核定的「人才培育方案」點出台灣人才問題，一、高等教育僵化，二、產學脫節、國際視野不足，三、欠缺吸引國外優秀人才誘因，四、優秀人才外流。據聞去年全國科技會議，簡報中四大問題依然還是問題。代工的產業模式，一度創造台灣的經濟奇蹟，但現在走入產業發展瓶頸，希望以創新取代代工。學者批評，政府高留住企業在台投資，給予租稅優惠、廉價水電成本，讓企業習於勞力密集的生產模式，造成企業怠惰，無助於產業轉型。另外，台灣對於僑生、留學生的栽培，恐也流於為人作嫁。勞委會曾針對有意留在台灣工作的畢業生，要求至少兩年工作經驗，外籍生只能回到母國或到他國，兩年後可能已失去對台灣的興趣。後來勞委會放寬限制，而台灣的「學術代工」，展現在整個大學評鑑制度只重視SCI、SSCI等論文指標。學者批評，這些期刊論文指標大多是西方思維，做關台灣社會切身問題的研究，很難在這些期刊中出頭。產業代工、人才代工、學術代工，三個代工思維讓台灣陷入人才危機泥潭而無法自拔，官員依然像個局外人般只會惘然。世新大學校長日前呼籲僑胞生來台的「三限六不」鬆綁，管中閔回應：「這不是專業問題，而是政治問題。」一語道破人才問題為什麼一直停留在「喊口號」。台灣如果真想解決人才問題，套句廣告詞：「Just do it! (做就對了)」

President Clinton lauds UCF collaboration with Orlando firms in commencement

Collaborations between UCF and companies in greater Orlando are a model for the rest of the United States, former President Bill Clinton told about 1,600 graduates and their guests at a commencement address this afternoon.

Calling himself "UCF's most ardent, unpaid flack," Clinton cited the confluence of the university and local technology firms, and lauded two UCF grads who have developed an on-campus idea into an international environmental group.

"We need each other. We need to grow together. We need to learn together," Clinton said. "Orlando works because there's a high level of collaboration" that has been recognized by outsiders.

He said the last remaining area of bigotry in the United States is our preference to be surrounded by people who agree with us. He urged the graduates to be different.

"Too many of us still believe our differences are more important than our common humanity," he told the students, who are graduating from the College of Health and Public Affairs and the Burnett School of Biomedical Sciences.

"The success of UCF, the success of Orlando...are testimony that no matter how righteous we are, how close to the truth we are, we do better when we work together."

Clinton, who was granted an honorary doctorate of humane letters, was the first president to speak at a University of Central Florida commencement since President Richard Nixon in 1973. Clinton had visited UCF twice before.

University President John C. Hitt lauded Clinton as a humanitarian who presided over the nation's "longest peacetime economic expansion."

Graduates said they were excited and honored to hear Clinton at their graduation, one of five commencements scheduled at the university this week. About 7,800 UCF students are earning their degrees during events that also commemorate the 50th anniversary of the state's largest public university.

Christina Colbert, a 22-year-old legal studies graduate from Daytona Beach, said she wanted to hear what Clinton would say about jobs. "That's everyone's main concern," she said.

Clinton told graduates to embrace opportunity like the two UCF students who in 2008 founded "IDEAS for Us," an organization that helps young people implement environmental sustainability ideas around the world.

"Most of the people who have ever lived on planet Earth never had the choices your degrees and your mortarboards give you. Most people didn't choose what they do for a living," Clinton said in his 23-minute speech. "Even in a tough economy, you have been given that."

He also encouraged them to make a difference. We have "more means to change the course of history than ever before" through technology, he said.

"It's an honor — anytime a U.S. president comes — it's awesome. It didn't matter which one," said Joseph Caesar, 28, of Fort Wayne, Ind. A public administration major, Caesar said he hoped to hear Clinton talk about public service. "At one point, he was a college graduate, too."

Clinton told the graduates that the 45 years since his graduation from Georgetown University has flown by.

"My advice — do what makes you happy," he said. "I hope you will do well. I hope you will do good. I hope you will have a good time doing it."
