VOLUNTEER HANDBOOK

Penghu possesses unique ocean resources and geological features. The ancestors overcame all kinds of obstacles and used their intelligence to survive on this land. The location of this project is Shili community known for its beautiful beach and the unique fishing and fish-processing practices. The main goal of this project is, with the help and creativity of the volunteers, to develop, design and build installation art work that would reflect the local culture and have more people interested in Shili community. It is also our hope that the international volunteers will get to learn about the culture of Penghu through participating in the project.

1. Volunteer must follow the rules and guidelines set by the host agency. Volunteers also must participate in the activities planned and the daily debriefing and discussion sessions.
2. Shuttle buses will pick up volunteers at the airport or port when volunteers arrive Penghu. Registration fee includes accommodation, insurance, and food during participation in the volunteer project in Penghu. However, travel to and from Penghu is **NOT** included.)
3. Project schedule: October 2st (Friday) ~ October 8th (Thursday). The starting date might be postponed due to local weather conditions.
4. Upon completion of the volunteer work, participants participating in



the entire project will be awarded with a certificate.

5. Transportation: To promote a sustainable life style and follow the local low-carbon policy, bicycles will be used as the main mode of transportation.
6. Over the course of the volunteer project, a significant amount of time is spent outdoors and some activities are rather labor-intensive. All participants must ensure their general state of health and fitness is good and must take full responsibility of their health and wellbeing.
7. Volunteers must complete the questionnaires distributed by the host agency.
8. Volunteers will make one post (including a photograph and a brief description) regarding the volunteering experience on Facebook **daily** over the course of the volunteer project (a total of 5 posts). By the end of the project, volunteers will also produce a 3-5 minute video about the volunteering experience. Volunteers will allow the host agency to collect and use photos, images, videos and audios produced regarding and during the volunteer project.
9. Room and boarding: Shared room (4 people/per room). The host agency reserves the right to make adjustments and changes in boarding arrangement based on availability.
10. All participants are responsible to have their own toiletry, sunblock lotion, hats, sunglasses, water bottles, and personal medication.
